School Community Relations

The School Committee affirms its belief that the public schools belong in every sense to the people who created them by consent and support them through taxation and other means. Further, the Committee believes that the schools can only be as strong as the intelligent and informed support of the citizens of the community. This support must be based on their knowledge and understanding of the school system and their participation in its aims and efforts. Therefore, the School Committee declares its intent to keep the citizens of Maynard regularly and thoroughly informed through all available channels of communication on all policies, programs, problems and planning of the school system. The Committee invites the advice and counsel of Maynard residents either at the scheduled meetings of the Committee, or of school groups, or through the Superintendent of Schools.
