



School Committee Policy:

#205

School Building Administration

Acting with the approval of the superintendent and upon the counsel of other administrators, the principals shall be the chief administrators of their schools. All personnel assigned to a building shall be directly responsible to the principal. Staff members who work in more than one school shall be responsible to the principal of each school in which they work during the time they are working there.

Within the constraints of Massachusetts General Law, the principal is charged with the supervision and direction of the staff and students assigned to the building and with the care of the school facility and its equipment. The principal shall see that school committee policies, the directives of the superintendent, and the guidelines for the instructional program are observed. Within the framework of the policies of the committee and the general rules and regulations set by the superintendent, the principal may establish and enforce such regulations as said principal deems advisable for the educational benefit of students and efficient operation of the school.
